Developed by child safety experts, it is used by schools, mentoring programs, foster care and adoption programs, juvenile justice systems, faith-based organizations, and many other types of youth-serving organizations. The Diana Screen® helps us ensure that everyone who works or volunteers with youth meets the highest standards of safety.

Quick Facts

- **Part of a larger process:** The Diana Screen is one component of our overall application process, along with background checks, reference checks, and interviews.

- **Languages:** Available in English and Spanish.
- **Privacy:** Applicants are identified by an ID number only—no names attached to results.
